

Dear Good Shepherd Parents,

My name is Patrick Temple and I'll be continuing the Kidtunes Guitar Program at Good Shepherd this fall. The program is for kids ages 5- 14. We will be working in groups of 2-4 students where the kids will be learning to read music as well as playing ensemble pieces. Students will be learning traditional finger style pieces as well as contemporary songs.

Classes are held after school during the week. The rates for lessons are \$48 a month for the first sibling, \$44 a month for the second sibling and \$38 a month for every sibling after that. If a student has to miss a lesson, a makeup lesson can be given after the student returns to school or at my studio if room in my schedule allows. A guitar is required and can be purchased quite reasonably from ToysrUs, Target or Kmart. They all carry the brand "First Act" and it is an excellent quality instrument for the price. Please let me know if you need any advice on picking the correct size for your child.

I have been teaching music lessons for over 20 years and along with Good Shepherd, I'm currently teaching group guitar classes as well as music theory and history classes at King's College. A little about my education background, I have a Master's degree in guitar performance and a Bachelor's degree in music theory. I have been teaching the Kidtunes program for 19 years and strive to continue improving what I feel is already an excellent program.
